# 10:30AM Service Palm Sunday

Receiving the Light, Being the Light, Sharing the Light of Jesus Christ



Today is Palm Sunday, when we remember Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem. The King of kings humbly rides on a donkey's colt, and in so doing he fulfills an ancient prophecy that proclaims him as Lord and Savior. Jesus declares that even if all were silent, the stones of the city themselves would still cry out in joy.
