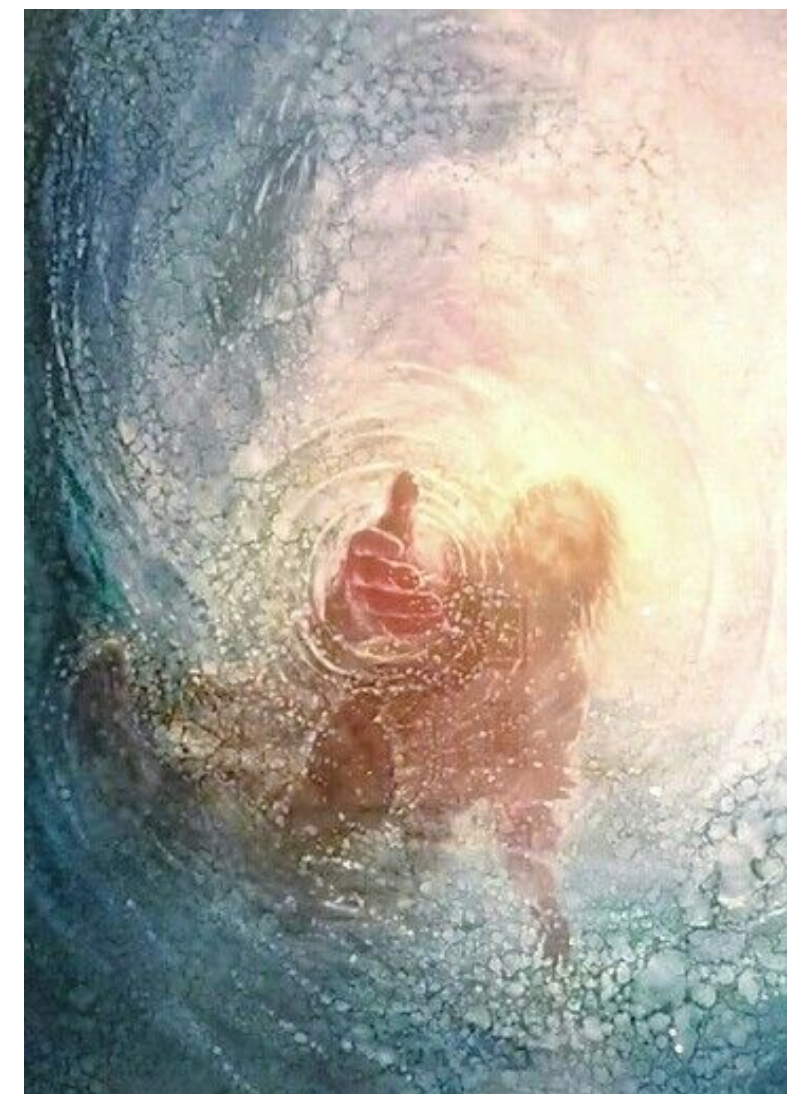

In Romans, Paul suggests the gift of salvation grows through belief from the heart. In Matthew 14, Jesus Walks upon stormy water and invites Peter to join him, but Peter's fear prevents him.
