

"One Body" August Sermon Series



In the letter to the Ephesians, Paul seeks to equip Jesus' disciples in understanding that they are all one body in Christ Jesus. Through the first of seven "I am" sayings in Johns' Gospel, Jesus reveals himself to be the Bread of Life, and the only way to eternal life. In the breaking of Jesus's body on the Cross, reflected in the breaking of Communion bread, we are invited to share in that life of self-sacrifice. It is in this place that enemies are reconciled, wounds are healed, and life in all its fullness is given to those who believe.
