

Epiphany of the Lord

Receiving the Light, Being the Light, Sharing the Light of Jesus Christ



Today we celebrate Epiphany, which falls on January 6 and is the climax of the Christmas season and the twelve days of Christmas. The term epiphany is Greek and means "to manifest" or "to show." The Epiphany season is associated with the first manifestation of Jesus—to the wise men, in his presentation in the temple, in his baptism, to his disciples, and in his first miracle. Today's lesson from Isaiah speaks of the light that will arise upon all people. In Matthew, the wise men also follow a light—a star that guides them to the Christ child, revealing to the world that this small infant is Lord and King, worthy of praise and worship.
