June 26, 2016 Sixth Sunday after Pentecost RECEIVING THE LIGHT, BEING THE LIGHT



The letter to the Galatian church emphasizes the freedom found in Christ—a freedom that is not manifest in self-indulgence, but in love and service of one another. In Luke 9, Jesus makes clear that discipleship is a radical act. Even as he invites people to follow him, he notes the cost of the decision, telling people that they cannot cling to their former lives and serve God's kingdom.
