Receiving the Light, Being the Light, Sharing the Light



Sometimes the workings of God remain unseen before they bear fruit – similar to a seed growing and taking root in the soil. In the Old Testament reading, Samuel, discerning that God would use David to sow the seed for Israel's future, trusts God's choice of the young shepherd David as king. In his second letter to the Corinthian church, Paul also emphasizes that discipleship demands walking by faith, not by sight. In Mark, Jesus uses the image of seeds to describe the mysterious and hidden nature of God's kingdom.
