

# January 20, 2019 Second Sunday after the Epiphany Receiving the Light, Being the Light, Sharing the Light



This morning's Scripture passage from Isaiah speaks of the intimate love God has for us, and how the Lord's people will be vindicated. Paul writes to the Corinthian church of the continued lavish outpouring of God's love through the gifts of the Holy Spirit. In John's gospel, Jesus performs his first miraculous sign – turning water into an extravagant volume of wine at a wedding feast in Cana. Today we welcome Dr. John E. Senior, Professor of Practical Theology and Religious Leadership at Wake Forest School of Divinity.
