Second Sunday in Lent

*Receiving the Light,
Being the Light,
Sharing the Light of Jesus Christ*



The lessons today encourage us toward faith and hope. In Paul's letter to the church at Philippi, he expresses grief over those who live as enemies of the cross, who set their minds on earthly things. He encourages instead the heavenly citizenship, where all humiliations are transformed. In Luke's gospel, Jesus has harsh words for the inhabitants of Jerusalem, who have continually fallen away from the faith of their ancestors. He calls them to repent and return to the fold under God's wings and near to God's heart, a fitting invitation to all of God's people during this Lenten season.
