



Transfiguration Sunday

RECEIVING THE LIGHT, BEING THE LIGHT, SHARING THE LIGHT



In today's Scripture passages we see Moses' face shining with the glory of God, having received the covenant of the Law from God's own hand. In Luke we see one of the most extraordinary events of the Gospels—the Transfiguration of Christ. High atop a mountain, Jesus is clothed in his majestic divinity, as Moses and Elijah appear from heaven to converse with him. The Apostle Paul later teaches that while Moses' face had to be veiled after encountering the Lord, through Christ we are given freedom to approach God boldly. Jesus has torn the veil between earth and heaven, and he invites us to enter the new covenant through faith.
