

First Sunday in Lent RCEIVING THE LIGHT, BEING THE LIGHT, SHARING THE LIGHT



Today is the first Sunday in the season of Lent, when we are invited to examine the roots of our Christian discipleship and to identify with Jesus' journey to the cross. In the painting above, we remember the suffering Jesus endured on the cross. The early Sundays are an opportunity to go deep into our hearts and minds, allowing the Spirit to lead us into the wilderness where we can recognize our estrangement from God, and aim to put things right.
