The First Sunday of Advent

Receiving the Light, Being the Light, Sharing the Light of Jesus Christ



Today we enter the season of Advent and the beginning of the church's liturgical year. Advent is the time we anticipate the coming of our Savior, Jesus Christ, both as the incarnate Christchild and his future coming to reign in glory in the consummated Kingdom of God. In today's Gospel reading, Jesus teaches about the fearsome majesty of his second coming, urging us to remain watchful, so that "when you see these things taking place, you know that he is near."
