

Paul reminds the hearers of his prayer of Ephesians 1:15-23 of the establishment of a new order. He was calling to the forefront of their faith God's new way of living under the Lordship of the one who became a slave to death. This order included the things found in Jesus's life, and the things found in Matthew 25:31-46. Clothing the naked, feeding the hungry, visiting those in prison, loving people with our lives and all that we have. Jesus in this gospel text goes as far to say, "just as you did not do to one of the least of these", you did not do for Jesus himself.
