

World Communion Sunday began in the 1930s in the United States, as a way to reflect on our global communion with Christians near and far. In Matthew's gospel, the chief priests question Jesus' authority as he teaches in the temple. The lesson from Philippians orients disciples to a new way of being—that they take on the mind of Christ.
