In Jeremiah Chapters 7 & 8 God instructs the prophet Jeremiah to tell God's people to amend their ways. They had been abusing the Temple of the Lord, neglecting people in need, worshiping false gods, and forgetting their own relationships with God. At this time the nation of Israel was under siege from other powerful nations and the people were returning to the Temple and their old rituals instead of trusting in and obeying the commands of God. We learn however, that Jeremiah prays for God's mercy, even for those who disobeyed.
